Prof Jeffrey V. Lazarus holds a joint position as an affiliated researcher at the WHO Collaborating Centre on HIV and Viral Hepatitis at Rigshospitalet, the University of Copenhagen and at the Institute of Global Health, Hospital Clínic, University of Barcelona. His decade-long career as a health systems, HIV and hepatitis expert at WHO's Regional Office for Europe was followed by three years at the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria, where he led knowledge translation.

While at WHO, Prof Lazarus cofounded the HIV in Europe Initiative, where he still sits on the steering committee. He now serves as the Board Chair of the foundation AFEW International, the editor-in-chief of Hepatology, Medicine and Policy, a steering committee member of the European Commission's new Joint Action on HIV, hepatitis and TB, and as of October 2016 he is a member of the EASL International Liver Foundation. He is the author of more than 200 publications and his current scientific work includes leading the Beyond Viral Suppression health systems study and the Hep-CORE, Hep-CoC and Hep-NORDIC studies.
