Dr. Stefan Wiktor is a public-health physician with more than twenty-five years' experience in epidemiologic research and the implementation of public-health programs. Dr. Wiktor is Professor of Medicine and Public Health at the University of Washington in Seattle, U.S. From 2012-2016, Dr. Wiktor was the Team Lead of the World Health Organization's Global Hepatitis Programme in Geneva, Switzerland which provides guidance and technical assistance to countries to promote the implementation of comprehensive viral hepatitis prevention and control programs.

Prior to 2012, Dr. Wiktor worked for the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, where he conducted research studies of HIV-1 and HIV-2 epidemiology in West Africa and led the implementation of a large-scale HIV/AIDS prevention and treatment program in Tanzania. He is the author of more than 100 peer-reviewed scientific publications.
